

Australian youth – Just looking forward to the future

Think all of today's youth are full of attitude and part of the 'emo' phenomenon? Well get ready to rethink these misconceptions, as recent research undertaken by [Just Car Insurance](#)* has revealed the youth of today are overall optimistic about the future, despite having concerns about their current financial situations and terrorism in Australia.

Results from the Just Car Insurance Youth Attitudinal study have found 66 per cent of youth are confident they will always be able to find a job, while a staggering 55 per cent of youth feel positive about their future financial prospects.

Andrew O'Hara, National Manager of Just Car Insurance said, "Youth of today are exposed to more information and world events than their parents at the same age, but despite this, they are still confident in their abilities and future prospects. Their resilience and optimism is amazing and their belief in their future achievements is admirable."

Despite overall positive attitudes, 54 per cent of the youth believe Australia is vulnerable to terrorism and 55 per cent often worry about their current financial situation. However, despite current financial concerns, 91 per cent of youth said they still hope to own their own home despite recent reports suggesting owning your own home is becoming increasingly unachievable.

The study also showed 79 per cent of youth would like to get married, with 52 per cent of respondents citing they have already met the person they want to spend the rest of their life with.
